Procedure:

- (1) Provide a scaled, extended plot plan with topography signed and stamped by a professional engineer licensed to perform required documentation. Plot plan shall show street and number; existing and proposed structure; subsurface water and drainage courses, if any; existing tanks or cesspools; existing and proposed subsurface storage tanks; property lines; public ways; rights of ways subject to herbicide / pesticide control; other potential sources of pollution such as private dump, animal waste (manure piles), agricultural herbicide / pesticide / fertilizer applications for more than 5 years, cemetery etc..
- (2) Site visit by Board of Health Agent to verify information provided on plot plan.
- (3) A satisfactory site visit will allow the Board of Health to issue a well site permit.
- (4) Well drillers report shall be submitted to the Board of Health within 30 days of completion.
- (5) Site inspection by Board of Health Agent.
- (6) A satisfactory completion site inspection will allow the Building Inspector to issue a building permit.
- (7) Prior to the use of private well water for human consumption a water quality report shall be performed by a laboratory licensed for water testing by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. A copy of the water quality report shall be submitted to the Board of Health. When a water quality report meets the standards established by the Board, well water may be used for human consumption and a certificate of compliance is issued.
