This Amendment is entered into this 24th day of March, 2025, by and between the Town of Dalton ("Town") and the Dalton Patrol Officers' Union ("Union"), by and through its duly authorized representatives.

WHEREAS, the Union has requested an amendment to the current contract because the previous amendment, containing the same provision as this amendment, was not included in the FY26 – FY28 contract.


WHEREAS, the parties have agreed to this agreement,

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to the following:


